WELCOME TO ELECTRA LAKE

GENERAL RULES

- Electra Staff may refuse entry of any visitor, water conveyance or pet
- Maximum speed limit on all roads and drives is 10 mph or 15 mph as posted
- Stop at the gatehouse and check out when leaving the premises
- No littering; please use trash receptacles; be "Bear Conscious"
- No smoking in public fishing areas, except where signs permit
- Please, no fires, loud noises, firearms or fireworks
- No overnight camping or leaving boats on property
- We love all animals, but please keep your pets on a leash
- Recreational use of Drones as a toy or tool is not permitted anywhere on/above Electra Lake or the surrounding grounds
- Visitors are responsible for their own personal safety and agree to absolve Electra Sporting Club and Public Service Company of any and all liability relating to injury while visiting Electra Lake

FISHING RULES

- Flies and artificial lures only
- Fish only in posted public fishing areas or boats
- No fishing within 500 feet of the dam
- Possession limit posted at gatehouse is strictly enforced
- Unlimited catch and release, no bait or barbed hooks
- Any fish that is injured must be kept
- No live bait or chumming
- One rod per person; NO DOWNRIGGERS
- No metal attractors with more than one blade
- Use of treble hooks is discouraged
- Do not clean fish in the lake; use the fish cleaning station. If fish cleaning station is not operating, fish must be cleaned at home
- Sometimes the fish cleaning station is crowded; please stop fishing and proceed to the fish cleaning station by 6:30 p.m.
- PLEASE BE COURTEOUS TO YOUR NEIGHBORS

BOATING RULES

- One approved personal float device per person on all boats, canoes and kayaks
- All boats must be inspected by Electra staff
- All boats/paddlers must comply with Colorado Boating Statutes and Regulations
- All boaters/paddlers must comply with Electra Sporting Club Rules
- Size Limits:
 - Outboards: 18 feet, 150 HP Inboards: 18 feet, 200 HP
- No houseboats, Wake Boats or Jet Skis
- All parties boating or paddling must have a cell phone that is registered with the Electra Sporting Gatehouse
- Maximum speed limit on lake is 40 mph


